AN ORDINANCE **86615**

AUTHORIZING THE RECOVERY OF ACTUAL COSTS ASSOCIATED WITH POLICE OFFICER (ON-DUTY AND OFF-DUTY) USE IN PROVIDING SECURITY AND TRAFFIC ENFORCEMENT FOR PARADES/SPECIAL EVENTS; AND REMOVING THE LIMIT FOR THE MAXIMUM NUMBER OF OFFICERS (25) TO BE BILLED FOR AND ALLOWING THE BILLING TO REFLECT THE ACTUAL NUMBER OF OFFICERS USED. THIS ORDINANCE SHALL NOT APPLY TO CITY-SPONSORED PARADES OR EVENTS.

(AMENDS CHAPTER 19 OF THE CITY CODE)

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City of San Antonio to assess fees to help offset the costs of providing services; and

WHEREAS, as a part of the FY97-98 City budget development process, there has been identified the need to add new fees and to adjust existing fees charged by the San Antonio Police Department; **NOW THEREFORE:**

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANTONIO:


SECTION 1. Section 19-440(b) of the City Code of the City of San Antonio is hereby amended to read, in its entirety, as follows:


(b) Prior to the issuance of a parade permit for a parade which is nonpolitical in nature, the applicant shall be required to file with the chief of police a surety bond as described in Section 1-16 of the City Code in an amount which will cover the estimated costs of barricading, policing and cleaning up the parade route. The permit holder shall receive from the city a bill for the actual cost of the parade within two (2) weeks after the parade. The payment for the cost of the parade shall be due to the city within thirty (30) days after the date of the parade. This paragraph shall


not apply to parades of a political nature. The permit holder shall bear all costs relating to traffic control devices and any on-duty and overtime police required for the event.

SECTION 2. This ordinance shall take effect on October 1, 1997.






